**SUBJECT: CONCEALED CARRY LICENSE EXPIRATION
EXTENSION NOTICE**

Based upon the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the legal recommendation of the Scioto County Prosecutors Office and the recommendation of the Scioto County Health Commissioner all routine non-essential services provided by the Scioto County Sheriff's Office Administrative Office continues to be suspended until further notice. This includes the processing of both new and renewed concealed carry licenses

House Bill No.197 signed by Governor DeWine on March 30, 2020 in part addresses the Ohio concealed carry licenses that expire on or after March 9, 2020.

Based on Ohio's previous concealed carry law there is a 30-day grace period where you may continue to carry a firearm after the expiration date on your license, and this still applies to licenses that expired prior to March 9, 2020.

House Bill No. 197 changes the following, in the event that your license expired or will expire on or after March 9, 2020, your license will remain active for 90 days past the expiration date or December 1, 2020 whichever comes first.

Sheriff Donini apologizes for any inconveniences this may cause the residents within Scioto County but states his main concern is for the safety of employees, inmates and you the residents of Scioto County.
